#### Dear Friends.

Today we celebrate the **Most Holy Trinity**. This is the truth, and at the same time, an astonishing mystery. We understand it with faith, which leads us to the truth. Jesus made a claim, which only God can make. He knows all things, the present and the past, as well as the future. Jesus is the truth and promises to send His disciples the Spirit of truth, who will guide them in understanding all that Jesus came to say and do!

Jesus tells His disciples that it is the role of the Holy Spirit to reveal what is true. It is through the gift and working of the Holy Spirit, who enlightens our hearts and minds, that we come to understand that the Godhead is a trinity of persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, perfectly united.

Jesus reveals the triune nature of God and the inseparable union of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, which is forever. Therefore, the mission of Jesus and of the Holy Spirit are the same, to reveal the glory of God and to share that glory with us by uniting us in a community of love with the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. That is why Jesus tells His disciples that the Spirit will reveal the glory of the Father and the Son and will speak what is true.

The ultimate end, the purpose for which God created us, is the entry of God's creatures into the perfect unity of the blessed Trinity. In baptism, we are called to share in the life of the Holy Trinity here on earth in faith, and after death, in eternal light.

How can we personally know the Father and His Son, our Lord Jesus Christ? It is the Holy Spirit who reveals the Father and the Son to us, and who gives us the gift of faith to know and understand the truth of God's word. Through the Holy Spirit, we proclaim our ancient faith in the saving death and resurrection of Jesus Christ until he comes again. The Lord gives us His Holy Spirit as our divine Teacher and Helper, that we may grow in the knowledge and wisdom of God. Let us seek the wisdom that comes from above, makes us able to be deepened in our faith, and to put into practice what we believe.




